

Doctrinal Session Topics

The Doctrinal sessions in *Apprentices in Faith* cover the breadth of Church teaching as presented in the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* using the same format of the four pillars.

Unit One presents how our belief is expressed through the Profession of Faith, the Creed. Unit Two presents how our belief is celebrated in the Liturgy and sustained by the Seven Sacraments. Unit Three presents how our belief conforms to the moral life in Christ. Unit Four presents how our belief is given voice in the vital relationship which is prayer.
